			The <b>transfer rules</b> allow claims for certain dependent relatives. In addition, are you, or would you like to provide support to a disabled person? Tax planning opportunities may be available, such as the establishment of a Registered Disability Savings Plan. Persons with <b>disabilities</b> may also receive tax relief for the cost of <b>disability supports</b> (e.g. sign language services, talking textbooks, etc.) incurred for the purpose of <b>employment</b> or <b>education</b> . If you or your dependents are disabled but do not have a T2201 Form, please provide details so we can explore whether you are eligible for special credits or benefits.

		6.	Did you purchase a new home in 2022? If so, you may be eligible for the new <b>residential property GST/HST rebate</b> . Also, are you a first-time <b>home buyer</b> in 2022? A federal tax credit based on \$10,000; may be available.
		7.	Are you a <b>U.S. citizen, Green Card Holder</b> , or were you, or your parents <b>born in the United States</b> ? You may have U.S. filing obligations.
		8.	Have you spent more than 200 hours acting as a <b>volunteer firefighter</b> or a <b>search and rescue volunteer</b> ? You may be eligible for a federal tax credit.
		9.	Are you an <b>aboriginal person</b> ? Special tax rules may apply.
		10.	Do you authorize CRA to give your name, address, date of birth, and citizenship to <b>Elections Canada</b> to update the National Register of Electors?
